
It is rich in natural spaces, historical places and resources offering different scenarios, which allow to change scenes in an instant and move to a different world without leaving the province.

In Pontevedra we can travel back in time or to another city: to the Barcelona of the 20s in *La sombra de la ley*, to the outbreak of the Spanish Civil War in *Los gozos y las sombras*, to the 40s in *A Private Affair*, to the 80s in *Cocaine Coast*, to the devastated country of Syria in *La unidad*, and even go back to the turbulent Middle Ages in *El final del Camino*.







WHAT DO WE OFFER

Production and shooting support services:

- · Assistance and guidance on finding locations for filming.
- Collaboration with both public and private entities for developing shootings.
 Intermediation with public and private institutions
- Creation of a permanent local partnership network in order to make the audiovisual work of producers and creators easier
- Guidance, advice, information and support regarding the necessary procedures to develop audiovisual projects in coordination with other local, regional and national administrations for processing all necessary licences, authorisations and documentation for shooting





- Support for audiovisual production companies wishing to shoot in the province of Pontevedra by acting as a liaison between film production companies, companies providing services linked to production, subsidiary companies and professionals in the film sector
- Assistance to the local film sector and companies in the province of Pontevedra
 related to these services by offering information on local companies and
 professionals in the sector, by acting as a liaison between film production companies
 and professionals, and those providing services and facilities for the film sector in
 the province, as well as advice and information
- Promotion and dissemination in the media.
- Development of national and international promotional campaigns together with the Spain Film Commission

THE PROVINCE OF PONTEVEDRA HAS EXCELLENT ROAD AND AIR CONNECTIONS:

- Modern transport network: well connected by land thanks to the high speed-train link between Pontevedra and Madrid.
- Two airports in the region: the closest airport to the town of Pontevedra is Peinador
 Airport in Vigo, just 30 km away. Another good option is Rosalía de Castro Airport in
 Santiago de Compostela, 74 km away, or even Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport in Porto,
 167 km away.

It also boasts a large and varied selection of hotels, accommodation establishments and restaurants, with an excellent value for money, and an exquisite cuisine
